

Training to become an Electroplater with Lufthansa Technik AG

In order to withstand the strains of daily operation, the surfaces of our aircraft must be very resistant. This is why we make the highest demands on the surface refinement of aircraft parts. As an Electroplater you are responsible for the refining of all the mechanical parts in the landing gear and engines, coating them with chrome, cadmium, silver or nickel and ensuring their hardness, as well as their protection against corrosion and wear. You prepare galvanizing baths and immerse the objects to coat them; by using electronic processes you put metal on surfaces and color it with the help of chemicals. You will work independently with documentation and regulations which are often written in English. And in our galvanizing operation, you will of course find out all about the environmental requirements of your job.
