- As of your third training year your assignments will take place directly in our shops which are responsible for the making and repairing of aircraft construction components and engine parts.
- If you show particularly good results during your qualification, you will also assist at other national locations for several weeks.

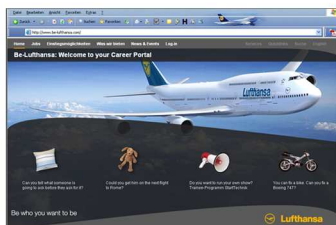
