Would you like to merge knowledge with experience? – Combine innovative studies in Aviation Management with vocational training to become an Air Traffic Management Assistant!

While learning the theoretical background at the EBS Universität für Wirtschaft und Recht (EBS), you will gain insights into the operative and business routine of the Lufthansa aviation Group. Experience abroad both during your studies and a practical internship, combined with English as the instruction language at the EBS, will make you fit for the international environment of our business sector. After three years and a future-oriented double qualification, you will know what's what – both in the world of entrepreneurial aviation and in the Lufthansa world.

Facts

- Within three years you will complete your studies at the EBS (Campus Rheingau in Oestrich-Winkel), and receive your Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) degree in Aviation Management.
- Your studies cover six semesters of 16 weeks each. You will spend your 4th semester abroad.
- Your studies focus on both general and aviation management. Courses and lectures are held in English.
- In parallel with your studies, you complete your vocational training with Lufthansa and pass your examinations with the IHK (Chamber of Commerce) Frankfurt to become an Air Traffic Management Assistant.
- During internal seminars, you will receive additional specialized air transport knowledge. In your practical internships, you will get to know our operative work in direct customer contact: at the Station, in Cargo and in Sales. One internship will take place abroad.
- Further practical internships will also give you insights into important administrative and managerial functions within our company. You will actively participate in various areas such as Marketing, Finance and Accounting or Network Management.
- The tuition fees for EBS are covered by Lufthansa.

Requirements

- General qualification for university entrance with very good Mathematics, English and German language skills
- Basic knowledge of common PC applications
- Interest in studying Aviation Management
- You can think beyond boundaries, are willing to achieve, team-capable and have entrepreneurial talent
- You have shown corporative or social commitment
- Experience abroad is desirable
- You must pass Lufthansa's and EBS' two-stepped selection process.
- Applicants must initially carry the costs for the EBS entrance exam. These costs will be reimbursed for the recruited participants once they have started their dual study program.
- Should the applicant pass the EBS entrance exam but be required to take part in preparatory classes (math and/or English), then the applicant must also carry the cost of the courses.
