## Training

- Training period: approximately 5 weeks, of which 4 weeks theoretical and 1 week practical training on board
- No remuneration during the training period, but all costs for hotels (in Dusseldorf and Munich) and transport will be covered by Eurowings

## Contract terms

- Contract length: 24 months
- Probation period: 6 months
- Uniform: will be made available to you by Eurowings
- Starting salary 1,664.26 € gross per month, currently 603.87 € are tax-free
- 13th month salary
- Absence compensation during flight assignments
- Remuneration of flight hour overtime
- Vacation time: 42 calendar days per year
- Regular time off: 9 days per month or 120 days per year
- Contributions to capital formation

## Requirements

- Secondary School Completion Certificate or High School Diploma
- Good written and spoken German and English language skills
- Height between 1.60m – 1.75m
- Authentic, stylish and well-groomed appearance combined with a confident and appealing demeanor
- Your weight should be in an appropriate ratio to your height
- Good general health
- Acuity +/- 5 diopter
- High level of dedication and resilience
- Accessible by telephone
- You must live near to your duty base (max. 50 km distance)
- Unrestricted driver's license (equivalent to German class III)
- Valid passport
- Non-EU country citizens must have a valid settlement permit for Germany

## Application steps

Candidates are pre-selected based on their written application documents according to Eurowings' requirement profile.

If your documents correspond with the profile requirements you will then be invited to a personal interview.

During this visit you will take part in a so-called Assessment Center during which applicants' capabilities to constructively solve problems dealing with customers are tested.

The last hurdle you will need to take before beginning your job above the clouds will be a medical airworthiness examination.
