

Purser (m/f)

Working on board of an aircraft still remains one of the most fascinating and interesting professions one can choose. As a Purser, you are responsible for managing and instructing your Flight Attendant team, as well as for a flight's onboard service and quality.

You are also actively involved in the familiarization of new Flight Attendants and Purses.

Aside from your assignments on short haul flights you will also substitute for the leading Purser on long-haul flights, taking over the responsibility for managing a compartment team.

Facts

- You will fly on continental and intercontinental routes from Munich.
- Your training to become a Purser will take round about 3 months and includes both classroom and practical flight training.
- For the length of your training you will receive a training contract with a subsequent working contract commitment.
- Once your training is completed, you will receive an unlimited contract with a 6-month probation period.
- After your training you will initially work as a responsible Purser on short-haul and after a further 3 months, on long-haul flights.
- You are entitled to 42 vacation days per year.

Salary

- During the training contract (3 months) € 2,400.- gross/month
- As of your appointment to Purser, following training completion € 2,913.34 gross/month (16.3 % shift bonus already included)
- Absence money per day: € 42.00 continental and € 48.00 intercontinental (partially liable to taxes and social security contributions)

Privileges

- Lufthansa pension benefits in addition to pension insurance
- Opportunity for you and your family, and your spouse/companion to buy reduced fare tickets (after 6 months)
- Lufthansa partakes in your uniform costs
- Many offers for qualified further education
- Special discounts from numerous hotels and car rental agencies

Requirements

- Proof of a total of 1,500 block hours on board as a Purser (CDC, responsible Flight Attendant with leadership qualification, or similar)
- You have been actively working as a Purser for the last 12 months before the Lufthansa training starts
- High level of service disposition and an open manner when dealing with people
- High degree of initiative, independence, flexibility, and operational readiness
- Aptitude for diplomacy, assertiveness within a team
- Very good German and English language skills, both in written and verbal form, and knowledge of a further foreign language
- Exemplary appearance
- Valid passport without entry limitations
